Head Start is one of the most successful Federal programs for pre-school children. Head Start works through a partnership with the community. Eighty percent of the funding is provided by a Federal grant. The remaining twenty-percent is matching in-kind funds generated from volunteer support, donated services, and participation of community members and parents. The Head Start philosophy is that parents, as primary educators of their children, must be directly involved with the program. Although Head Start is a Federal program, it is operated by community based organizations that best meet the needs of the local community. The Northeast Nebraska Community Action Partnership operates the Stanton Head Start Center. Through the educational, social, medical, and nutritional services provided, Head Start gives children a chance to grow up healthy, happy, and confident.

All of the children in Head Start are between the ages of three and five years old. Head Start attends to the development of each child with attention to individual strengths and needs. Children with disabilities are included in the regular program, with individual education and special services as needed. Children leave Head Start prepared for Kindergarten, excited about learning, and confident in their abilities to succeed.

The Stanton Head Start Center is located at 507 7th Street. The center is funded to serve seventeen to twenty children and families. The staff includes a Family Service Worker, Teacher, and Teacher Aide. Staff members are Casey Johnson, Family Service Worker/Aide; Tracy Sporleder, Teacher; Chelsea Boelter, Nutritional Teacher Aide/Assistant; and Megan Pankoke, Nutritional Teacher Aid/Assistant.

To apply, contact the center at (402) 439-2255 or Northeast Nebraska Community Action Partnership at 800-445-2310. Applications are taken year around. Preference is given to four-year-olds so they may receive preschool services before entering Kindergarten. Any child who is 3 by July 31st is encouraged to apply. Head Start accepts children and families from low income as well as over income households. The Northeast Nebraska Community Action Partnership encourages children with disabilities to apply. A waiting list is maintained so openings may be filled as they arise.
