Availability of the agenda was communicated in a posted and/or advertised notice and current copy of the agenda was maintained as stated in the notice. All proceedings of the Board of Education, except as may be hereinafter noted, were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public. Abbreviations: AMPVF- All members present voted for, MC- Motion carried.

A regular meeting of the Stanton Community Schools Board of Education was convened in open and public session on Monday, August 14, 2017 at 7:00 p.m. in the High/Middle School Library, at the Stanton Community High School, 1007 Kingwood, Stanton, Nebraska. The meeting was called to order by President John Mandl.

Roll call was taken and the following board members were present: Wendy Benson, Colleen Butterfield, Sarah Klinetobe, John Mandl, Shad Pohlman, and Tim Reese. Also present were Michael Sieh, David Cunningham, Mary McKeon, and Kim Hoehne.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by all present. President John Mandl announced the location and informed the public of the current copy of the Open Meetings Act posted in the Library meeting room.

Motion was made by Shad Pohlman, seconded by Tim Reese to declare the meeting open, and properly posted and/or published by advanced notice in accordance with board policy #8342 with the agenda given to the president of the board and all members prior to the meeting date. AMPVF-MC.

Motion was made by Colleen Butterfield, seconded by Sarah Klinetobe to approve the board agenda. AMPVF-MC.

Minutes from the July 17, 2017 regular board meeting were approved and accepted by the Secretary.

A public forum was held.

Elementary Principal Mary McKeon reported on the beginning of school information and summer school.

Secondary Principal David Cunningham reported on 1-1 student computer quotes, 1-1 Manual, back to school picnic for staff, the possibility of hiring another secretary/paraprofessional, resignation of classified staff, volunteer contracts, activity start dates, Gatorade scrimmages and dates of first fall contests.

Superintendent Michael Sieh reported on completed summer projects, future elevator valve replacement, architect letter of agreement for a new K-12 facility model, upcoming year budget strategies, yearend transfers, monthly bills, the second reading of board policies, and upcoming meetings and conferences.

Motion was made by Sarah Klinetobe, seconded by Colleen Butterfield to accept the bid from Connecting Point for student computers in the amount of \$54,165.00. Ayes: Wendy Benson, Colleen Butterfield, Sarah Klinetobe, John Mandl and Tim Reese. Nay: Shad Pohlman. Motion Carried.

Motion was made by Wendy Benson, seconded Shad Pohlman to accept the resignation of Erica Roberts with regrets. AMPVF-MC.

Motion was made by Colleen Butterfield, seconded by Tim Reese to approve the volunteer coaching contracts for assistant One-Acts between the school district and Josh Bleich, and between the school district and Ashley Kingham for the 2017-2018 school year. AMPVF-MC.

Motion was made by Tim Reese, seconded by Wendy Benson transfer \$30,000 from the General Fund to the Hot Lunch Fund. AMPVF-MC.

Motion was made by Sarah Klinetobe, seconded by Wendy Benson transfer \$20,000 from the General Fund to the Activity Fund. AMPVF-MC.

Motion was made by Tim Reese, seconded by Colleen Butterfield transfer \$10,000 for future track renovation from the General Fund to the Depreciation Fund account. AMPVF-MC.

Motion was made Shad Pohlman, seconded by Colleen Butterfield to approve the second reading of board policies #1200, 3130, 3131,3131.1, 3570, 4003, 4028, 5004, 5413, 5418, 6800, 8130 & 9330. AMPVF-MC.

Motion was made by Sarah Klinetobe, seconded by Shad Pohlman to a) approve & authorize payment for District #3 bills presented at this meeting; b) accept the Activity Account Reports; c) accept the Treasurer's Report; d) accept the Account Summary Report; and e) accept the Revenue Report. AMPVF-MC.

The next regular monthly meeting will be September 11, 2017 at 7:00 p.m. in the High School /Middle School Library. The budget hearing will start at 6:40 p.m.

The meeting was duly adjourned at 8:40 p.m.
