Availability of the agenda was communicated in a posted and/or advertised notice and current copy of the agenda was maintained as stated in the notice. All proceedings of the Board of Education, except as may be hereinafter noted, were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public. Abbreviations: AMPVF- All members present voted for, MC- Motion carried.

A regular meeting of the Stanton Community Schools Board of Education was convened in open and public session on Monday, June 11, 2018 at 7:00 p.m. in the High/Middle School Library at the Stanton Community High School, 1007 Kingwood, Stanton, Nebraska. The meeting was called to order by President John Mandl.

Roll call was taken, and the following board members were present: Wendy Benson, Colleen Butterfield, John Mandl, and Tim Reese. Absent: Sarah Klinetobe and Shad Pohlman. Also present were Michael Sieh, Mary McKeon, David Cunningham, and Kim Hoehne.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by all present. President John Mandl announced the location and informed the public of the current copy of the Open Meetings Act posted in the Library meeting room.

Motion was made by Wendy Benson, seconded by Tim Reese to declare the meeting open and properly posted and/or published by advance notice in accordance with board policy #8342 with the agenda given to the president of the board and all members prior to the meeting date. AMPVF-MC.

Motion was made by Tim Reese, seconded by Colleen Butterfield to excuse Sarah Klinebobe and Shad Pohlman from the June 11, 2018 board of education meeting due to personal circumstances. AMPVF-MC.

Motion was made by John Mandl, seconded by Colleen Butterfield to approve the board agenda. AMPVF-MC.

Minutes from the May 14, 2018 regular board meeting were approved and accepted by the Secretary.

Guests were welcomed. One patron addressed the board during the public forum.

Elementary Principal Mary McKeon presented the 2018 Mathematics, Physical Education & Integrated Science textbook/material proposal and reviewed the 2018-2019 Elementary Student/Parent Handbook.

Secondary Principal David Cunningham reviewed the 2018-2019 1-1 computer, certified staff, non-certified staff, and secondary student handbook handbooks, sought approval for a certified staff contract, sought acceptance of a classified staff resignation and presented the state track qualifiers & medalists for recognition.

Superintendent Michael Sieh gave an update on the summer custodial projects, reviewed the monthly bills, requested approval of the Superintendent to sign state & federal forms; sought naming the official paper & banking institutions for the 2018-2019 school year, reviewed the NASB award of achievement data, and discussed development of a memorial policy.

Motion was made by Wendy Benson, seconded by Tim Reese to approve the math textbook/materials proposal from Houghton Mifflin Harcourt in the amount of \$43,578.63, physical education textbook/materials proposals from McGraw-Hill Education in the amount of \$2,430.53, and physical education & science textbook/materials proposals from Pearson in the amounts of \$1,724.14 & \$3,903.53. Motion was made by Colleen Butterfield, seconded by Tim Reese to approve the contract between Michelle Hasebroock and the Stanton Community Schools for the position of elementary instructor for the 2018-2019 school year. AMPVF-MC.

Moved by Wendy Benson, seconded by Colleen Butterfield to accept the resignation of Norman Pabaira with regrets. AMPVF-MC.

Motion was made by Colleen Butterfield, seconded by Tim Reese to recognize and congratulate the following students for qualifying for the Class "C" State Track Meet: Teena Beel - 800 meter run & 1600 meter run; Cade Goger – 100 meter run & 1600 meter relay; Jasmine Kment – 200 meter run; Sydney Mitchell – Unified Long Jump & 100 meter run; Bailey Patterson - 3200 meter run; Sutton Pohlman - 1600 meter relay; Broderick Sieh - 800 meter run & 1600 meter relay; Beau Wilke – Long Jump & 1600 meter relay; Ben Wilke – Shot Put; Parker Zach - 3200 meter run and their coaches Dave Ernesti, Matt Alexander, Patric Brechbill, Julie Cunningham, Bryan Mendlik & Sierra Zach; and to recognize and congratulate Cade Goger, Sutton Pohlman, Broderick Sieh & Beau Wilke for placing 7th in 1600 meter relay at the Class "C" State Track Meet. Motion was made by Wendy Benson, seconded Colleen Butterfield to authorize the Superintendent of Schools, Dr. Michael J. Sieh, to act on behalf of the Board of Education when making applications and requesting reimbursements for all state and federal programs for the 2018-2019 school year. AMPVF-MC.

Motion was made by Tim Reese, seconded by Wendy Benson to officially name the Stanton Register as the official paper for the Stanton Community Schools for the 2018-2019 school year. AMPVF-MC.

Motion was made by Colleen Butterfield, seconded by Tim Reese to officially name the Stanton State Bank and the First Nebraska Bank of Stanton as the official banking institutions for the Stanton Community Schools for the 2018-2019 school year. AMPVF-MC.

Motion was made by John Mandl, seconded by Colleen Butterfield to a) approve & authorize payment for District #3 bills presented at this meeting; b) accept the Activity Account Reports; c) accept the Treasurer's Report; d) accept the Account Summary Report; and e) accept the Summary Statement of Revenue. AMPVF-MC.

The next regular monthly meeting will be July 9, 2018 at 7:00 p.m. in the High School /Middle School Library.

The meeting was duly adjourned at 7:45 p.m.
