

# STANTON COMMUNITY SCHOOLS

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October 8, 2018

The complete text of the Minutes, Resolutions, and Policies are on file at the Stanton Community Schools Superintendent's Office and are available for public inspection during regular business hours. Availability of the agenda was communicated in a posted and/or advertised notice and current copy of the agenda was maintained as stated in the notice. All proceedings of the Board of Education, except as may be hereinafter noted, were taken while the convened meeting was open to the attendance of the public. Abbreviations: AMPVF- All members present voted for, MC- Motion carried.

A regular meeting of the Stanton Community Schools Board of Education was convened in open and public session on Monday, October 8, 2018 at 7:00 p.m. in the High/Middle School Library, at the Stanton Community High School, 1007 Kingwood Street, Stanton, Nebraska. The meeting was called to order by President John Mandl.

Roll call was taken, and the following board members were present: Colleen Butterfield, Sarah Klinetobe, John Mandl, Shad Pohlman, and Wendy Benson. Absent: Tim Reese. Also present were Michael Sieh, David Cunningham, Mary McKeon, and Kim Hoehne.

The Pledge of Allegiance was recited by all present. President John Mandl announced the location and informed the public of the current copy of the Open Meetings Act posted in the Library meeting room.

Motion was made by Shad Pohlman, seconded by Wendy Benson to declare the meeting open and properly posted by advance notice in accordance with board policy #8342 with the notice and advance agenda given to the President of the board and all members prior to the meeting date. AMPVF-MC.

Motion was made by Sarah Klinetobe, seconded by Colleen Butterfield to excuse Tim Reese from the October 8, 2018 board of education meeting due to family circumstances. AMPVF-MC.

Motion was made by Colleen Butterfield, seconded by Shad Pohlman to approve the board agenda. AMPVF-MC.

Minutes from the September 10<sup>th</sup> budget hearing, tax request hearing and regular board meeting was accepted by the Secretary.

A public forum was held. Guests were welcomed.

Elementary Principal Mary McKeon reported that the NSCAS and ACT test results will be released in December instead of October, gave an ILCD committee update and reported a 98% attendance rate for the K- 6 fall parent/teacher conferences.

Secondary Principal David Cunningham requested approval of employment for a bus driver and reported a 72% attendance rate for the 7-12 fall parent/teacher conference.

Superintendent Michael Sieh presented bids for a special education van and an activity van; reported on two additions to the buildings, grounds and transportation action plan; presented the annual budget, finance & grants action plan; discussed certified staff negotiations; reviewed the monthly bills; provided conference and workshop information; presented the fall district enrollment figures; and reported on receiving the 2018 AdvancED Distinction of Quality Award for Nebraska & requested permission to attend the conference in Chicago to accept the award.

Motion was made by Shad Pohlman, seconded by Wendy Benson to approve employment of Becky Houdek as a bus driver at \$18.59/hour. AMPVF-MC.

Motion was made by Shad Pohlman, seconded by John Mandl to accept the bid for Woodhouse for a special education van in the amount of \$23,790.00. AMPVF-MC.

Motion was made by Colleen Butterfield, seconded by John Mandl to accept the bid for Courtesy Ford for a 10-passenger activity van in the amount of \$25,684.00. AMPVF-MC.

Motion was made by Sarah Klinetobe, seconded by Colleen Butterfield to approve the budget, finance & grants school improvement action plan. AMPVF-MC.

Motion was made by Wendy Benson, seconded by Shad Pohlman that the Education Association be recognized as the exclusive bargaining agent for the Stanton Community Schools' certificated employees as defined by Neb. Rev Stat. § 79-824, as well as the guidance counselor, technology coordinator and media specialist but excluding administrators as defined in Neb. Rev Stat. § 79-101, for the 2020-2021 contract year. AMPVF-MC.

Motion was made by John Mandl, seconded Colleen Butterfield to a) approve & authorize payment for District #3 bills presented at this meeting; b) accept the Activity Account Reports; c) accept the Treasurer's Report; d) accept the Account Summary Report; and e) accept the of Revenue Report. AMPVF-MC.


The next regular monthly meeting will be November 12, 2018 at 7:00 p.m. in the High School /Middle School Library.
