The Return to School Protocol was created for use by teachers, students, parents, and the community of Stanton.

The intent of the Return to School Protocols is to bring a predictable, consistent, and transparent response to a global pandemic. | COVID-19 Positive Cases & Return to school | SCS will follow Health Department Guidelines. Anyone with fever of 100.4 F. or above and/or one or more of the following symptoms: a new cough, new onset of shortness of breath or new loss of taste or smell should not return to school until 24 hours symptom free. | | | |
| Student/staff illness while at school | Students who become ill should be masked (if not already) and separated in a space with minimal (preferably one) staff until parent or guardian can pick up the student. Staff attending to the student to follow infection control best practices for COVID-19. Clean/disinfect relevant areas. • Students and staff immediately isolate in the designated area and sent home as soon as possible. • Require the symptomatic person to wear a cloth or surgical mask while waiting, if tolerable. | | | |

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| Pick-up/Drop-off of Students | Do not congregate at entrance/exit while waiting for students. Parents/Guardians - please stay in vehicle. |
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| Hand Washing & Sanitizing | • Students and staff wash or sanitize their hands upon entering the building (i.e. first classroom a student enters), entering and exiting individual classrooms, entering, and exiting cafeteria, and exiting building. |
| Entering Building Hand sanitizer will be available.
